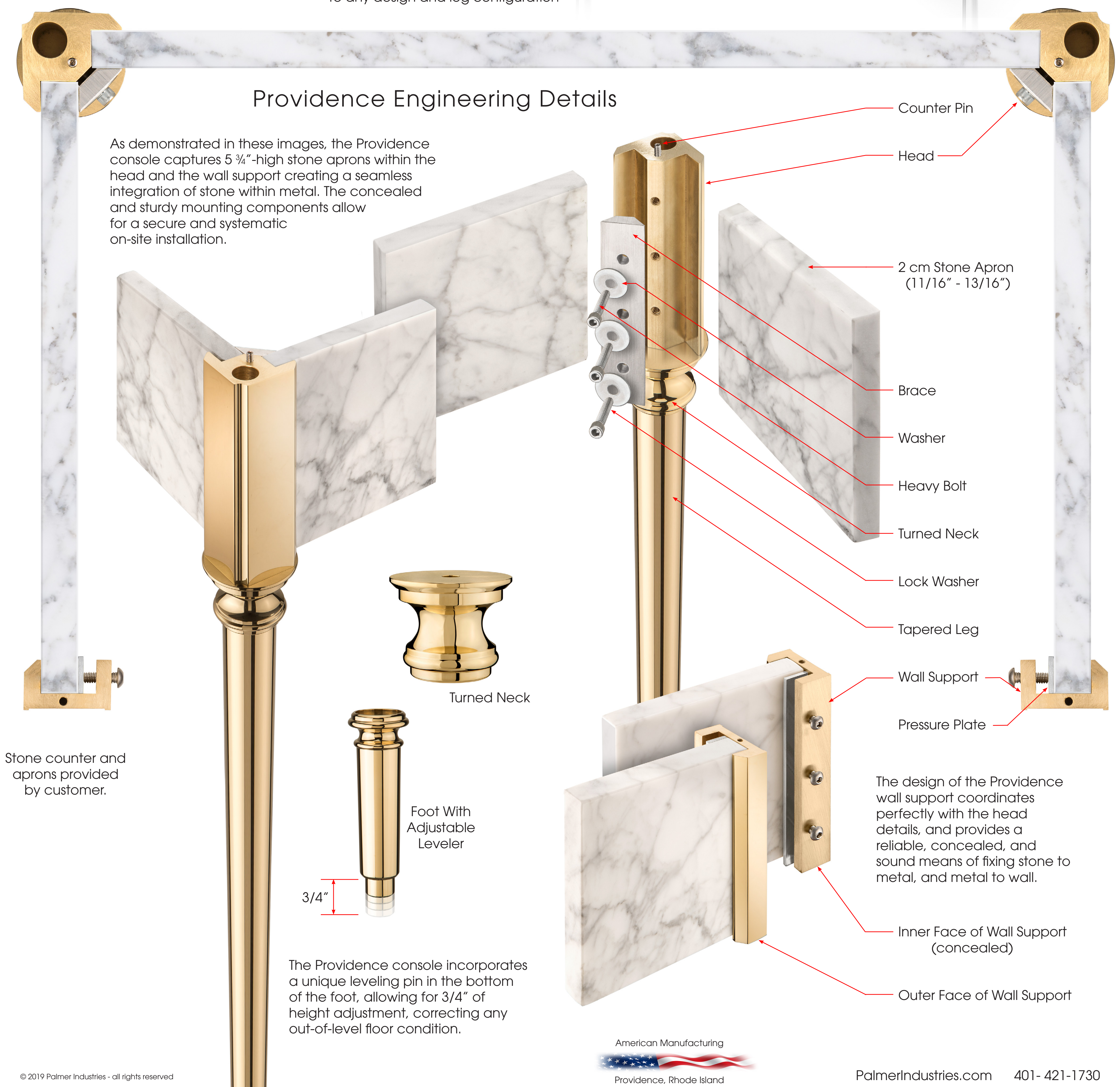
The Providence model features a truly unique and well-engineered system of incorporating stone aprons (a "skirt") directly into the head of the leg, affording a truly seamless complement to the counter material above, while concealing the sink basin and hardware below. The square head and decorative turned neck, together with the mild taper of the leg, continuing to the floor through the foot, all marry in perfect proportion to define the stately design of this console.

Providence Engineering Details

As demonstrated in these images, the Providence console captures 5 3/4"-high stone aprons within the head and the wall support creating a seamless integration of stone within metal. The concealed and sturdy mounting components allow for a secure and systematic on-site installation.

The Providence console incorporates a unique leveling pin in the bottom of the foot, allowing for 3/4" of height adjustment, correcting any out-of-level floor condition.

The design of the Providence wall support coordinates perfectly with the head details, and provides a reliable, concealed, and sound means of fixing stone to metal, and metal to wall.
